



CREATE is a program to support independent theatre artists during the COVID 19 pandemic.

CREATE will offer 50 discreet days of work for NT theatre artists.

Artists will be given the opportunity to utilise the Brown's Mart office and rehearsal room to work on their practice.

Artists might use the time to:

- work on their skills
- create new work
- develop existing work
- develop their arts business
- think

A wage of \$280 for the day will be paid to artists, with tax withheld where appropriate and Superannuation contributions made to the artists nominated fund.

As part of their day, artists will be expected to spend one hour contacting our patrons by phone. This activity is not about eliciting donations or selling tickets, it is about connecting audience and artists and maintaining that relationship throughout these physically distanced times.

Applications will be assessed monthly.

Applications will close:

- 27 April 2020 for activity occurring in May
- 18 May 2020 for activity occurring in June
- 15 June 2020 for activity occurring in July

Artists will be able to access a maximum of 4 discreet days and preference will be given to artists that have not previously accessed the program.

This program is designed for individuals. Groups of up to four will be considered, however strict physical distancing will need to be adhered to.

Applications will be assessed against their artistic potential and their connection with our audiences.
